


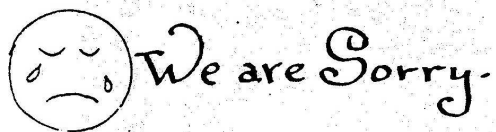

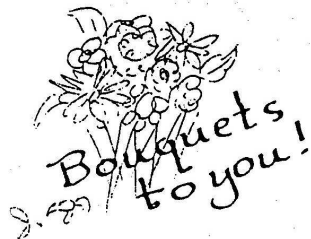
1. Please, try to acknowledge each cover you receive with one of yours in return. We know it takes some of you longer to do this, but keep in mind It is more blessed to give than receive."
